

Activity Suggestions for Pay Equity Day, April 9, 2013

1. Wear **RED** and encourage male and female friends to wear **RED** to symbolize women are still in the **RED** on pay equity.



2. Write a letter to the editor of your local paper.



3. Hold a rally!



4. Ask your Mayor to proclaim April 9th as Pay Equity Day in your town.



5. Call and/or write to your state legislators, Congressman, and Senators.

6. Form a Wage Club for April 9th to get women to talk about the wage gap. www.wageproject.org



7. Ask local businesses to give 23% off to female customers on Pay Equity Day, April 9th.



8. Join the National Committee on Pay Equity. www.pay-equity.org



9. Hold a press conference.



10. Encourage men's organizations to host activities in observance for Pay Equity Day.



11. Ask a local bookstore to host a group discussion on pay equity.

12. Ask your local bar to host an unhappy hour.

13. Bake brownies or cookies for your colleagues with 23% missing to symbolize the wage gap between men and women.
